**Sanction # 032-02**

**Location:** The Duncanville Natatorium is located at 900 W. Camp Wisdom in Duncanville, Texas. From I-20, just take the Camp Wisdom exit and travel south to the southwest corner of Camp Wisdom and Cedar Ridge.

**Pool:** Duncanville Natatorium is a 25 yard, 8 lane, indoor pool with Colorado Timing System. Spectators may bring their own chairs or use the bleachers. The “blue bench” area on the deck is reserved for the swimmers. Spectators should sit in the “red bleacher” area.

**Concessions:** Concessions will be available. **NO FOOD OR DRINKS** allowed in the pool area. Hospitality will be available for coaches and officials. Psyche sheets will be available.

General warm-up will last 30 minutes – **NO DIVING**. The last 15 minutes of Session 1 and 3 shall consist of the following:

<b>Lane 2, 3, 6, &amp; 7</b>	<b>Racing Starts, One Way Only</b>
<b>Lane 4 &amp; 5</b>	<b>General Warm-up, No Diving</b>

**Rules:** HELD UNDER THE SANCTION OF USA SWIMMING, INC., NORTH TEXAS SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT AT THIS MEET.

This meet will observe the following:

1. No recall on false starts.
2. Whistle commands (short series of whistles for heat preparation, followed by long whistle for step up, or step in).

**Eligibility:** NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE ENTRANT IS AN **ATHLETE MEMBER OF USA SWIMMING, INC.** EVERY CLUB ENTERED AS A TEAM IN A NORTH TEXAS SWIMMING SANCTIONED MEET SHALL BE A MEMBER OF USA SWIMMING, INC. THE **2002 USA REGISTRATION NUMBER** MUST BE INCLUDED WITH EVERY ENTRANT.

**Age Limit:** Swimmer’s age as of July 27, 2002.

**Entry Limit:** Each swimmer may participate in four (4) individual events and one (1) relay event per day. Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the start of the meet.

**Entry Forms:** Teams are encouraged to submit their entries on Hytek Team Manager Software, plus the required hard copy of the team's entries. If entries are not on Hytek software, please make one copy of the attached consolidated entry form for each swimmer entered in the meet.

**Entry Fees:** \$2.25 per individual event and \$4.50 per relay team. Make checks payable to SWAT. Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each session at \$4.50 per individual event and \$4.50 per relay team.

**Entry deadline:** All entries must be received no later than 6:00 pm on July 16, 2002 in order to be included in the Psyche sheet and avoid late entry fees. Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the scheduled start of each session. Send entries to Southwest Aquatics of Texas (SWAT), P.O. Box 380554, Duncanville Texas 75138. **Absolutely no entries will be accepted by phone or fax.**

**Seeding:** The meet will be seeded on deck. Late entries will be seeded according to submitted times. Seed times entered should be swimmer's best time for the stroke and distance. If the swimmer has not previously competed in the stroke and distance, N.T. (no time) shall be entered.

**Check-In Procedure:** Positive check-in is required – indicated by a (√) next to the swimmer's name. The check-in deadline is thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of each event. Scratch: or no check mark indicates the swimmer will not be swimming that event.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded for places 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>. Ribbons will be awarded for places 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> in individual events, and 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> for relay events. "A", "BB", and "B" certificates will be awarded to all swimmers achieving "A", "BB", and "B" standards. Best time ribbons will be awarded to 8 & under for all swimmers who swim an individual event faster than their seed time. Events will be swum together and awarded separately. Meet will be scored and plaques or trophies will be awarded to the top three teams based on % of best times.

**Scoring:** Team points will be calculated and awarded as follows: Individual events, 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Relay points will be doubled.

**Results:** Final results will be mailed to all participating teams within ten (10) days after the meet. Additional copies may be ordered at the Clerk of Course for \$4.00 each.

**Sanction:** THIS MEET WILL BE HELD UNDER THE SANCTION OF UNITED STATES SWIMMING, INC., UNDER SANCTION NUMBER #032-02. IN GRANTING THIS SANCTION IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT USA SWIMMING, INC., NORTH TEXAS SWIMMING, INC., SWAT, THE CITY OF DUNCANVILLE, DUNCANVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND ALL MEET OFFICIALS SHALL BE FREE FROM ANY LIABILITIES OR CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES ARISING BY REASON OF INJURIES TO ANYONE DURING THE CONDUCT OF THIS EVENT. DAMAGE TO A FACILITY, WHEN PROVED, WILL CAUSE THE OFFENDING SWIMMER(S), IF UNATTACHED, OR THE OFFENDING SWIMMER'S CLUB, IF ATTACHED, TO BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR REPAIRS.

**Timers:** Each team must provide one (1) timer for every ten (10) swimmers they have entered in the meet. Lanes will be assigned on a % of swimmers basis.
