WELCOME

The Dallas Mustangs Swim Team invites you to join us at Loos Natatorium in Addison, TX to compete in the Haunted Hat Division 2 B/C short course invitational.

LOCATION: Alfred J. Loos Natatorium, 3815 Spring Valley Rd., Addison, Texas

An indoor 50 meter pool divided into two eight-lane 25 yard competition pools, each with a Colorado Timing System. Two warm-up/cool-down lanes. Large bleacher seating areas are located above each pool.

MEET SCHEDULE:

Session I – Saturday AM	Warm-up 8:00am – 8:30am	Meet Start 8:45am
Session II – Saturday PM	Warm-up 11:30am – Noon	Meet Start 12:15pm
Session III - Sunday AM	Warm-up 8:00am – 8:30am	Meet Start 8:45am

POOL ASSIGNMENTS:

Session I - Saturday AM	8 & U will swim in the deep end only.
Session II - Saturday PM	10 & U, 11-12 Girls will swim in shallow end. 10 & U, 11-12 Boys will swim in deep end.
Session III - Sunday AM	10 & U, 11-12 Girls will swim in deep end. 10 & U, 11-12 Boys will swim in shallow end.

The Meet Referee and Meet Director may decide to change the pool assignments based on numbers of entries. If there is a change, the new assignments will be posted on the North Texas Swimming web site; www.ntswwim.org and the Dallas Mustangs web site; www.dmswwim.com no later than Monday, October 26, 2009.

SANCTION AND LIABILITY:

This meet will be held under the North Texas Swimming, Inc. Sanction No. 037-09. No entries will be accepted unless the entrant is an athlete member of USA Swimming, Inc. Every club entered as a team in a North Texas Swimming, Inc. sanctioned meet must be a member of USA Swimming, Inc. USA Swimming registration numbers must be placed on the consolidated swimmer entry form.

“IN GRANTING THIS SANCTION AND BY ANY PERSON’S PARTICIPATION IN THE MEET IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT USA SWIMMING, INC., NORTH TEXAS SWIMMING, INC., ALL MEET OFFICIALS, THE DALLAS MUSTANGS SWIM CLUB AND THE DALLAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE FREE FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITIES OR ANY CLAIMS FOR ANY DAMAGES, EVEN IF SUCH LIABILITIES OR CLAIMS ARE DUE TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS, ARISING BY REASON OF INJURIES TO ANYONE DURING THE CONDUCT OF THE MEET.”

Damages to the facility, when proved, will cause the offending swimmer, if unattached, or the offending swimmer’s club, if attached, to be held accountable for repairs.

RULES:

Current USA Swimming, Inc. Rules and Regulations apply. North Texas Swimming, Inc. safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet. Pool deck access is limited to swimmers, coaches, officials, timers, and meet personnel only. Parents and other spectators must remain in the bleachers above the pool. No chairs allowed in the bleacher area except for "stadium seats." No standing along the railing. No food or drink (except water) is allowed on deck.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

There will be no lane assignments and no racing starts during the first 20 minutes of warm-up. During the last 10 minutes of warm-up the following procedures will be in effect:

Lanes 1 & 8	Push Starts, Pace, No Diving
Lanes 2 & 7	Racing Starts, One-Way, Exit far end of pool
Lanes 3, 4, 5 & 6	General Warm-Up, No Diving

The center well (between bulkheads) will be closed during warm-up, although the Meet Referee may decide to open it should the need for additional warm-up lanes exist.

ELIGIBILITY:

Swimmer's age as of October 31, 2009 determines the swimmer's age for this meet. A swimmer may enter any event for which they are eligible to compete at the "B/C" level. A swimmer may not enter any event in which he/she has achieved a "BB" time. However, an exception is granted to swimmers with no more than 2 "BB" times. These swimmers may swim those events as exhibition (no awards or team points). **No entries will be accepted unless the entrant is registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Every club entered as a team, in a North Texas Swimming, Inc. sanctioned meet, must be a member of USA Swimming, Inc.**

ENTRY LIMIT:

Each swimmer may participate in a maximum of 5 individual events per day and one relay per day.

ENTRY FEES:

\$3.25 per individual event, \$6.50 per relay team

ENTRY DEADLINE:

Entries must be submitted by **October 20, 2009** by E-mail (preferred method) to MustangMeets@tx.rr.com with an attached file of the meet entries report by name and a meet entry fee report. All team entries shall be submitted using the team entry software adopted by the North Texas Swimming, Inc. House of Delegates. Any team submitting more than 5 individual entries; which are not submitted using this standard software, shall pay double the entry fees to the Dallas Mustangs.

- Fees must be mailed and postmarked by the entry deadline of **October 20, 2009**. Teams submitting fees not postmarked by the entry deadline shall be billed late entry fees for all entries.
- The name, phone number, and E-mail address of the person preparing the team entries must be provided with the entries.
- All teams must provide a printout of meet entries and a printout of individual entries, by name using the North Texas Swimming, Inc. standard team entry software.
- To avoid late entry fees, all entries and fees are due by Tuesday, October 20, 2009. Make checks payable to: **Dallas Mustangs**. Complete USA #'s are required for all entries. No entries will be accepted unless the entrant is registered with USA Swimming, Inc.

Relay entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet.

LATE ENTRIES:

Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each session at \$9.75 per individual event. All late entries must be accompanied by the swimmer’s valid USA Swimming ID card and a copy of the swimmer’s best times report from the USA Swimming, Inc. SWIMS database; no exceptions. (NT Policies & Procedures 6.3.B) **NO DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

SEEDING:

All events will be conducted as timed finals. Seed times entered should be the swimmer’s fastest meet time for the stroke and distance. If the swimmer has no meet time, enter the seed time as “NT” (No Time).

CHECK-IN:

Positive check-in is required. The check-in deadline is 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each event. There are three options:

- indicates the swimmer will swim the event
- Scr indicates the swimmer will not swim the event
- indicates the swimmer will not swim the event

AWARDS AND SCORING:

Ribbons will be awarded for individual event places 1-8 and for relay places 1-3. “Best Time” ribbons will be awarded to 8 & U in individual events swum faster than their seed time. NT does not count as a valid seed time toward “Best Time” ribbons. Team points will be calculated, but no team awards will be given. Final team scores will be printed in the final results. Swimmers 10 & U and 11 – 12 will swim together but will be scored separately.

PSYCHE SHEETS:

Will be available for \$5.00.

CONCESSIONS:

Available for the general public and swimmers, upstairs in the west hall. No food or drink (except water) is allowed on deck.

HOSPITALITY:

Available for coaches and officials only, in the lower front entry area. No swimmers are allowed in the hospitality area.

TIMERS:

The host team will provide as many timers as possible. However, it is requested, as a courtesy that all teams provide at least one timer for every 10 swimmers entered in the meet for all sessions.
