WELCOME

The Dallas Mustangs Swim Team invites you to join us at Southern Methodist University to compete in the 29th Annual Mustang Classic long course timed finals “A” meet.

LOCATION: A. R. Barr Outdoor 50 Meter Pool on the Campus of Southern Methodist University.

MEET SCHEDULE:

Session I – Friday PM	Warm-up	12:00 – 12:45 PM	Meet Start	1:00PM

Session IV - Sunday PM	Warm-ups for session 4 will begin immediately upon conclusion of Session 3; estimated to be 11:30am, but will in no event begin before 11am. The warm-up period will last for 45 minutes. The meet will start one (1) hour after warm-ups begin.			

PLEASE NOTE:

***Due to graduation ceremonies being held at SMU, we will have no swim sessions on Saturday.**

SANCTION AND LIABILITY:

This meet will be held under the Sanction of USA Swimming, Inc. Sanction No. NT 024-10. No entries will be accepted unless the entrant is an athlete member of USA Swimming, Inc. Every club entered as a team in a North Texas Swimming sanctioned meet must be a member of USA Swimming, Inc. USA Swimming registration numbers must be placed on the consolidated swimmer entry form.

“IN GRANTING THIS SANCTION AND BY ANY PERSON’S PARTICIPATION IN THE MEET IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT USA SWIMMING, INC., NORTH TEXAS SWIMMING, INC., ALL MEET OFFICIALS, THE DALLAS MUSTANGS, AND SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY SHALL BE FREE FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITIES OR ANY CLAIMS FOR ANY DAMAGES, EVEN IF SUCH LIABILITIES OR CLAIMS ARE DUE TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS, ARISING BY REASON OF INJURIES TO ANYONE DURING THE CONDUCT OF THE MEET.”

Damages to the facility, when proved, will cause the offending swimmer, if unattached, or the offending swimmer’s club, if attached, to be held accountable for repairs.

RULES:

Current USA Swimming, Inc. Rules and Regulations apply. North Texas Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

There will be no lane assignments and no racing starts during the first 30 minutes of warm-up. During the last 15 minutes of warm-up the following procedures will be in effect:

Lanes 1 & 8	Push Starts, Pace, No Diving
Lanes 2, 3 & 6, 7	Racing starts, one-way, exit far end of pool
Lanes 4 & 5	General warm-up, no diving

MEET OPERATIONS:

All events will be conducted as timed finals and will be **deck seeded** by computer. **Positive check-in is required.** See CHECK-IN Section for details.

The 12 & Under swimmers will swim events together but will be awarded separately, by age group. The 13 and Over swimmers will also swim events together but will be awarded separately, by age group.

All swimmers in the 400 Free and 400 IM must provide their own timers for the event. These events will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating heats of women and men. Events 51 and 52 (13 & Over 400 Freestyle) may be swum two swimmers per lane if needed to maintain a reasonable timeline. The decision will be made at the sole discretion of the meet referee based on the number of entries and scratches.

ELIGIBILITY:

Swimmer's age on May 14, 2010 determines the swimmer's age for this meet.

A swimmer may enter any event in which the swimmer has achieved the "A" qualifying time standard. Furthermore, a swimmer who has achieved three current "A" times may enter any event up to the daily limit.

ENTRY LIMIT:

A swimmer may enter a maximum of four (4) individual events on Friday and four (4) individual events Sunday.

ENTRY FEES:

\$3.50 per individual event, \$7.00 per relay event.

LATE ENTRIES:

Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each session at \$10.50 per individual event. All late entries must be accompanied by the swimmer's valid USA Swimming ID card and a copy of the swimmer's best times report from USA Swimming's SWIMS database. (NT Policies & Procedures 6.3.B). **NO DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

ENTRY DEADLINE:

Entries must be submitted by Tuesday, **May 4, 2010** by E-mail (preferred method) to MustangMeets@verizon.net with an attached file of the meet entries report by name and a meet entry fee report. All team entries shall be submitted using the team entry software adopted by the NTS House of Delegates. Any team submitting more than 5 individual entries, which are not submitted using this standard software, must pay double the entry fees to the Dallas Mustangs.

- Fees must be mailed and postmarked by the entry deadline of May 4, 2010. Teams submitting fees not postmarked by the entry deadline will be billed late entry fees for all entries.

- The name, phone number, and E-mail address of the person preparing team entries must be provided with the entries.
- All teams must provide a printout of meet entries and a printout of individual entries, by name using the NTS standard team entry software
- To avoid late entry fees, all entries and fees are due by Tuesday, May 4, 2010. Make checks payable to: **Dallas Mustangs**. Complete USA #'s are required for all entries. *No entries will be accepted unless the entrant is registered with USA Swimming, Inc.*

Relays entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet.

CHECK-IN:

All events will be conducted as timed finals and will be deck seeded by computer. **Positive check-in is REQUIRED!** Swimmers and coaches should take note of the following check-in procedure:

1. An **X** or \surd -indicates swimmer is present and intends to swim the event.
2. **Scratch** or **SCR** -indicates the swimmer has decided not to swim the event.
3. Failure to positively check-in or to scratch indicates the swimmer is not swimming for reason unknown.

CHECK-IN DEADLINE FOR EACH EVENT WILL BE 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED START OF THAT EVENT.

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded for places 1-3 in individual events. Ribbons will be awarded for places 4-8 in individual events.

Additionally, awards will be given to the swimmer scoring the highest number of points, by gender, in his or her age group (10 & U, 11-12, 13-14 and 15 & O).

SCORING:

Team points will be awarded for swims as follows: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Relay points will be double. Team awards will be given for first through third place teams.

POOL MEASUREMENT: The competition course length has been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Rules. The water depths of the competition course measured from 1 meter to 5 meters on the starting end is 6'0" and is 4'0" on the turning end.

TIMING SYSTEM: The Colorado System 5 electronic timing system with electronic scoreboard will be used. Two watches per lane will be used as a back-up.

HEAT SHEETS:

Heat Sheets will be available for a one-time charge of \$5.00.

FINAL RESULTS:

Final results will be posted on the North Texas Swimming Website as soon as possible following the conclusion of the meet. Paper copies may be ordered from the Clerk of Course for a fee of \$5.00 per copy.

CONCESSIONS/HOSPITALITY:

Concessions will be available for spectators. A hospitality area will be provided for all officials, coaches and volunteers.

OTHER INFORMATION:

BEHAVIOR: It is expected that all persons attending the meet will respect the pool facilities and display good sportsmanship behavior at all times. Defacing SMU property may result in a swimmer being expelled from the meet.

PLEASE NOTE:

- No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
- No smoking is allowed in the pool area, on the pool deck, or on the ramps or stairs at the pool entrances.
- No photo capable cell phones are allowed in the dressing areas or in the restrooms.

PARKING PASSES:

Parking passes will be sold on deck for \$10. These passes should be hung on the rear view mirror and will permit holders to park both days in the Moody garage located adjacent to the pool.

CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:

The meet directors/meet referee reserve the right under USA Swimming rules to cancel events should the meet run later than expected. In the unlikely event that an event(s) are cancelled due to reasons other than inclement weather, those swimmers affected may apply for a refund by contacting the meet director.
